

VENUE VISUAL GUIDE



I am going to see a show at the Lemon Tree, 5 West North Street, Aberdeen, AB24 5AT.



This is Lemon Tree, where the performance will take place. This is what the venue looks like from the outside.



This is the main entrance. I will walk through the door below the sign "Lemon Tree".



This is the box office.

This is where I can buy tickets or collect prepaid tickets for the show. If I have an e-ticket on my phone, or already have my tickets, I do not need to go to the box office.

There may be a small queue and the foyer may be quite busy with lots of other people around.



The performance will take place in the Studio.

There will be a member of staff present. They will check my ticket before I go in.



Auditorium/ Performance space: Shō and the Demons of the Deep takes place in a traditional theatre.

I will watch the performance in this room. There will be seats facing the stage. I can take any seat I like.

If I need to sit in a specific part of the auditorium, I should let the usher know as early as possible before the show.



When the show is ready to start, the lights will dim and the actors will come out onto the stage.

The actors will not talk directly to me during the play. The actors will be in character at all times.

I will need to be quiet while watching the show.

If I need to go to the toilet, I should look for the signs or ask an usher for directions.



If I find sounds or lights disturbing during the show, I can ask a member of staff for earplugs, ear defenders or dark glasses at any time.

I will need to return these items after the performance.



At the end of the show the audience will clap to show the actors that they enjoyed the show.

When the clapping has ended, the lights will get brighter. This means the show is over. I can now leave the theatre.

I should exit back through the way I came in.
